Existing Functionality Changes

System Time Out – Login returns you to page you were working on (PROD-6644)

When you log back in after an automatic time out you will now be returned to the page you were working on. The return page will be remembered for the current day and then reset to the home page the following day.


Note: If your session on a desktop site times out and the next time you login is on a mobile device, you will be returned to the mobile version of the page (if available).

If the page you were viewing is not available on the mobile site, you will experience a page layout issue, and should click back on your browser to login again and go to the mobile home page (known issue PROD-7325).


Absence Planner Quick Entry new warning message where holiday request exceeds entitlement (PROD-2686)

Employees requesting holiday via the Absence Planner page will now see the same message as the Time Off page, if the number of days/hours requested exceeds their remaining entitlement.



Error message bar now automatically extended to display the message (PROD-1540)

Visibility of errors has been improved so you no longer need to click on the red bar to view the message as it will be automatically expanded.





Optional Modules

Safeguarding Report Improvements

Additional configuration has been added to **Reports > Specialist Reports > Safeguarding Report** to improve control over data output.

New slider toggles have been added as detailed below, and all settings on this page will now be remembered as the user's preference when they next run the report.



New Safeguarding 'Include Notes' slider toggle (PROD-7086)

A new 'Include Notes (will return multiple rows per employee)' slider toggle has been added which provides a choice of whether to include the Notes column.

Disabling the toggle means the Notes column will be excluded and therefore only one row per employee will be included in the report export.



New Safeguarding 'Include all employees' slider toggle (PROD-7146)

A new **'Include all employees'** slider toggle has been added which can be enabled if the user wishes to report on people who don't have the relevant safeguarding check on record.

API – Absence Key Improvements (PROD-6822)

An update has been made to the API key for Absence data, in order to restore the expected functionality for customers in the Azure environment.

Note: This improvement is separate to the HR software but is included in the release notes for reference, as it will be updated as part of the 2024-2 release.
